NOTICE OF EXTRAORDINARY MEETING



An Extraordinary Meeting of Slaugham Parish Council has been duly requested by three Members of the Council in accordance with Standing Order 3.4. and the Local Government Act 1972.

The meeting will take place on: Tuesday 26 May 2026 at 6.30pm at MacNaughton Hall, Old Brighton Road South, Finches Field, Pease Pottage

The purpose of the meeting is to consider the District Plan Post-Hearings Update published on 15th May 2026, including the proposed site allocations currently identified for further testing within Slaugham Parish. This meeting is being held to advise the community of the plans current position and to gather information and feedback from local residents. Your views will assist the Parish Council in identifying local priorities and concerns that will assist the Council in determining its position and next steps ahead of the public consultation later this year, should these sites complete their final testing.

This meeting does **not** form part of the formal consultation process and does **not** indicate any support for, or opposition to, the proposed allocations. It is an opportunity to share information, raise issues, and help inform the Council's preparation for the statutory stages to come.
