NOTICE OF VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF PARISH COUNCILLOR

If you would like to help develop, improve and protect your local community for the future, why not join the Parish Council as a co-opted councillor until the next elections

To be eligible you must qualify under *one* of the provisions of Section 79 of the Local Government Act 1972, i.e.

- a) be on the electoral register for the Parish;
- b) have owned or rented land in the Parish for 12 months;
- c) have worked in the Parish for 12 months;
- d) have lived in the Parish or within 3 miles of the Parish boundary for 12 months.

Must be of 18 years of age or over.

Members are bound by the Local Government Code of Conduct

The council currently meet approximately every 5 weeks, with planning meetings held on the first Thursday of the month or as required, the full council do not meet in August or December. It is responsible for managing the Parish Precept, considering local planning applications, maintaining the Recreation Ground and representing residents' views and interests in such matters as roads, services and future development. The Council responds to Government, County and District Council consultations, and is a member of the Sussex & Surrey Association of Local Councils.
