Mid Sussex District Plan - District Council Members voted on the District Plan to move forward to Regulation 19. This consultation is open from 12 Jan 2024 at 08:00 to 23 Feb 2024 at 23:59. The consultation documents can be viewed at https://midsussex.inconsult.uk/districtplanreg19/. Supporting evidence is accessible from this webpage. Slaugham Garden Nursery - Enforcement Officers and legal team have visited the site and notices will be served to tidy up the site.

DM/23/2174 Modification of Section 106 Agreement relating to application DM/16/2531 to remove Clause 4 of the first schedule so as to remove the requirement to pay the Affordable Housing contribution and to review the viability of the leisure. Community building and local community infrastructure contributions as set out in clauses 1 to 3 of the first schedule. An independent valuer has been appointed to review the case. This will come before the planning team in January 2024.
DM/23/2398 Land to the west of, London road, Handcross, West Sussex - Change of use of land from unused agricultural land to day care facility for rooddog (doggy day care) to include a reception timber cabin (3m x 6m) and 4 x timber cabins for dog shelters (3m x 4m each), re-use of the existing access gate and fencing to the perimeter of the site. Permission was refused.
Green Spaces Contract - The Cabinet awarded Goods and Services contract for a 10-year term of five plus five years subject to satisfactory completion of financial validation and expiry of the 10-day standstill period. to Glendale Countryside Ltd on the 2 December.

Dog Bins Collection - The situation is bad alongside street cleansing. This has been raised with cabinet.

- 11. Highways/Footpaths: to review highways projects/items: To update members of the following:
 - 11.1. Preliminary Enquiries TRO Proposal Staplefield Road B2114 Extension of the 30mph speed limit approx. 300 meters. The Clerk has not yet received a response from Nymans in relation to more information on the TRO.
 - 11.2. Footpath/s improvements- West Park Road/ Coos Lane to Covert Mead/Horsham Road Improvements have been made to area, Members to investigate as to whether more work is required to improving the area for residents. There is parking on the verge that is untidy could be approved and to be added to the highway project list.
 - 11.3. Preliminary Enquiries TRO Old Brighton Road/Cotsford/Barn Close Introduction of controlled parking zones, yellow lines etc. County Highways officer was to inspect the area there are no further updates currently.
 - 11.4. Highway/Green damage land fronting the Heritage, Park Road, Slaugham Park Road, is an adopted road by highways. The road is breaking up between the village green and the road creating a small ditch between the green and the highway. The use of the green as patron parking by the Heritage alongside the water running down Park Road had engendered damage to the green. The Clerk has asked the Highways Officers to visit the site and assess the damage, recommend, and assist in identifying a permanent approved solution before spending resources on temporary repairs, as these are unlikely to resolve the issue and potentially cause further issues.
