4 steps to take if someone is having a cardiac arrest.

Cardiac arrests can happen to anyone, at any time. The following steps give someone the best chance of survival.

If you come across someone in cardiac arrest:

1. Always Call 999

2. Start CPR

Cardiopulmonary resuscitation

Cardiopulmonary resuscitation is an emergency procedure that combines chest compressions often with artificial ventilation in an effort to manually preserve intact brain function until further measures are taken to restore spontaneous blood circulation and breathing in a person who is in cardiac arrest.

- 3. Ask someone to bring a defibrillator if there's one nearby.
- 4. Turn on the defibrillator and follow its instructions.

If you are advised to evacuate your home by the emergency services:

Please check on any neighbours who are elderly or disabled and or do not have access to communication equipment. It is your duty to notify the emergency services if there is a problem.

- Turn off electricity, gas and water supplies and unplug appliances.
- Take your mobile phone and charger.
- Take some spare clothes.
- Take prescribed medication.
- Take cash and credit cards.
- Lock all doors and windows.
- If possible, take your pets with you. Otherwise, make sure they are somewhere safe with food & water.

If you leave by car, take bottled water, a duvet or blankets and tune into the local radio for emergency advice and instructions.
